This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with the format in Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) Subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; proposals are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued. The solicitation, N00173-09-R-JS03, is issued as a Request for Proposal (RFP). The solicitation document and incorporated provisions and clauses are those in effect through FAC 2005-30 and DFARS Change Notice 20090115. The associated small business size standard is 500 employees. NRL has a requirement for a replacement to the current Hydraulic Power Unit (HPU) associated with the Three Axis Flight Simulator (TAFS) located in the Central Target Simulator (CTS) Facility. Delivery and acceptance is at NRL, Washington, D.C. 20375, FOB Destination. Delivery shall be no later than 180 days from date of award. The provision at 52.212-1, Instructions to Offerors-Commercial, applies to this acquisition.

The provision at FAR 52.212-2, Evaluation--Commercial Items is incorporated. The Government intends to award a contract resulting from this solicitation to that responsible offeror whose offer conforming to the solicitation will be the most advantageous to the Government, price and other factors considered. The offeror's proposals should clearly indicate how their proposed solution will address the detailed requirements that have been cited in Section 3 of the specifications. The following factors shall be used to evaluate the offers: past performance, technical capability of the item offered to meet the Government requirement and price. The technical factors are more important than cost and all factors are listed in descending order of importance.
