This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with the format in Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) Subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; proposals are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued. The solicitation, N00173-09-R-SC07, is issued as a Request for Proposal (RFP). The solicitation document and incorporated provisions and clauses are those in effect through FAC 2005-35 and DFARS Change Notice 20090721. The associated small business size standard is \$14,000,000.00 dollars.

The Naval Research Laboratory's (NRL) Center for Computational Science (CCS) has a requirement for (a) Liebert Chilled Water Units; and (b) all associated labor and installation in accordance with the specifications. The requirements for this acquisition shall include: CLIN 0001 Two (2) Liebert CW114DCSA3, 460 Volts, 60Hz, 3 Phase Precision Cooling Systems 1 (LO).

The desired Liebert Precision Cooling HVAC units are presently the only ones manufactured that have the required capacity, link to existing control and alarm systems and software, and parts that are compatible with existing installed facility HVAC systems to support the CCS supercomputer environment. No other type will satisfy agency requirements.

The equipment is capable of interfacing with all existing computer HPCC hardware, mechanical devices and similar HVAC support components, which include multiple air handlers, seven power distribution and conditioning systems, an uninterruptible power supply, two chilled water pumping stations, manifolds, booster pumps, the chemical ion exchange water purifier, and a computer monitoring system that links HVAC to power conditioning to building alarms to alert critical HPC systems for emergency shutdown.

Delivery and acceptance is at NRL, Washington, D.C. 20375, FOB Destination. Delivery shall be no later than thirty (30) days from date of award.

The provision at 52.212-1, Instructions to Offerors-Commercial, applies to this acquisition. The provision at FAR 52.212-2, Evaluation--Commercial Items is incorporated. The Government intends to award a contract resulting from this solicitation to that responsible offeror whose offer conforming to the solicitation will be the most advantageous to the Government, price and other factors considered. The following factors shall be used to evaluate the offers: technical capability of the item offered to meet the Government requirement and price. The technical factors are more important than cost.

In accordance with paragraph (j) of FAR 52.212-3 if changes to the ORCA annual representations and certifications apply to this acquisition, the offeror must clearly identify the applicable paragraphs at (b) through (i) which the offeror has completed for the purpose of this solicitation only. Any changes provided by the offeror are applicable to this solicitation only, and do not result in an update to the representations and certifications posted on ORCA.

Failure of a prospective offeror to attend the site visit or submit questions will be construed to mean that the offeror fully understands all requirements of the solicitation. No individual site visits will be scheduled.

The event will provide potential offerors with the opportunity to tour the Center for Computational Science facility, to gauge the effort required to disconnect, remove and properly dispose of the two existing 30-ton glycol cooled units located at NRL, Bldg A49, Room 108B. Potential offerors will have the opportunity to observe the current

chilled water unit installation and make measurements and notes needed for proposal preparation. Offerors may also observe building and staging areas for equipment and materials, and satisfy themselves regarding all general and local conditions that may affect the price. In no event shall failure to inspect the site constitute grounds for a claim after contract award.

Questions WILL NOT be answered during the site visit. No explanation, remarks, or replies made by Government personnel during the site visit shall be construed as changing the terms or conditions of the solicitation. Responses to questions will be posted as well as any amendments resulting from the site visit.
