

Q1. With regards to solicitation N00173-09-R-SK06, it appears that in Section L, a "Travel and Material Estimate" is not listed. Are we to assume Travel and/or Material purchases will not be required for this contract effort?

A1. Yes.

Q2. Also, we read Section L-14 (a) to bid actual for positions in which resumes are being provided. Is this correct?

A2. L-14 paragraph 1(a) states:

(a) The offeror shall submit a business proposal that includes a cost proposal with supporting information for each cost element consistent with offeror's cost accounting system. The supporting breakdown should include such elements as materials, direct labor, indirect cost, and other costs such as travel. The offeror shall provide exhibits as necessary to substantiate each cost element. Should rates be used in the proposal which are not DCAA approved, the offeror shall provide complete documentation and the rationale for their use at time of proposal submission. However, offerors are advised to use actual labor rates of proposed personnel as the basis for estimating labor costs when practicable.

Q3. Is this solicitation a follow on of an existing award or evolution of an existing award? If so who is the incumbent company/division?

A3. This is a follow-on effort to part of the effort performed under contract N00173-03-C-2037. See A4 below.

Q4. Could you please tell me who the current incumbent is for this work?

A4. The incumbent is:

Q5. I noticed in that in the pre-solicitation notice that it states this procurement is the follow-on to contract number N00173-03-C-2037. I was a little confused because contract # N00173-09-C-2038 was awarded in April 2009 and also stated that it was the follow-on to N00173-03-C-2037. Has N00173-03-C-2037 been split into two different requirements or has N00173-09-C-2038 been ended early?

A5. The effort performed under N00173-03-C-2037 was split into 2 different requirements.
