The purpose of this amendment is to answer questions received from potential offerors, to correct Section I, to revise the DD 1423, and to revise the DD 254 in the solicitation. The questions and answers are as follows:

1) Question: In the Statement of Work, under Task 6, paragraph 3.6.3 (4) identifies eleven subcontractor companies as participants in hard coating alternative programs, but Section L-16, Estimated Other Direct Cost (ODC), contains no provision for subcontracts under Task 6. We request that NRL review estimate and revise it if warranted.

Answer: The following is added to Section L-16, Task 6, on page 47:

Subcontractor Cost (per year) for Base Year and 4 (four) Option Years, Task 6:
\$450,000.

2) Question: In section L-14, Anticipated Labor Requirements, Task 7 (Page 40) of the solicitation anticipates 1,040 hours per year in the consultant category, but Section L-16, Task 7, anticipates \$20,000 per year in consultant costs. In comparison, Task 8 with 400 hours in the consultant category also anticipates \$20,000 in consultant cost. Please review the ODC estimate for Task 7 and revise it, if warranted.

Answer: The ODC estimates for Tasks 7 and 8 are consistent with historical data. No change is warranted.

3) Question: Paragraph 3.3.6, Statement of Work establishes security classification of SECRET for some subtasks under Task 3, but specifically establishes an UNCLASSIFIED classification for subtasks performed at NIST under Task 3. Paragraph 3.2.6 establishes a classification of SECRET for Task 2 in its entirety. Section 3.2.1 establishes the same work in Task 2 is to be performed with NIST. Should Task 2 subtasks involving collaboration with NIST also be UNCLASSIFIED?

Answer: All subtasks involving collaboration with NIST will be UNCLASSIFIED.

4) Question: Is the experience in lieu of degree acceptable for employees with sufficient applicable experience and education to fill labor categories requiring a bachelor's degree? If so, how much experience is considered equivalent.

Answer: Experience in lieu of formal degree is acceptable. Unless the Government has specific requirements or guidance, I suggest the following equivalency: BS = 5 years of experience; MS = 10 years of experience; and PhD = 15 years of experience. However, the experience must be quantifiable, not simply the number of work years. Examples include the demonstrated use and operation of specific administrative or management skills as appropriate for a specific task.

5) Question: The solicitation talks about materials for storage and conversion. Does this mean that basic research including some preliminary results of the materials in a device (i.e. fuel cell, capacitor, battery) or is the Navy looking for full device as an end product of the research?

Answer: While the NRL group working on this task does conduct basic research on materials for energy storage and conversion, the contractor supporting this task will NOT be involved with these studies. Instead, the contractor shall support this group through materials and device preparation, characterization and testing as directed. These devices will include sensors, batteries, fuel cells, ultracapacitors, and/or other devices.

6) Question: How many total awards does NRL expect to give out? Is there any limit on the amount of funding one can ask for over the five-year period of performance?

Answer: The number of awards for Task 7 is unknown but expected to be one. The amount of funding expected for this task is limited to the amount of direct labor hours and ODC specified in the RFP.

7) Question: Does the Navy have specific devices or power goals in mind with this research, or is the solicitation looking for general power output improvements for fuel cells/ultracapacitor and batteries technology through materials enhancements?

Answer: The NRL group does have specific device and power goals that have been defined by their sponsors. However, goals are NOT part of this RFP. The NRL group will conduct work to meet these goals, the contract will conduct work, as directed, to support the NRL group.

8) Question: Under heading "E. Past Performance," the RFP requires submission of relevant history information showing quality of work performed, timeliness, cost control, etc. There is another paragraph on page 36 of the RFP describing what is required to be submitted on "Past Performance Information", (a), (b), and (c), please advise us to whether we have interpreted the past performance requirements properly.

Answer: The other paragraph entitled "Past Performance Information" on page 36 is necessary and must be labeled as Section L-12(A). Past Performance Report is not included in the number of pages required under Section L-11(2).

Section F-2(a) is revised to read as follows:

"The term of this contract is from the date of award through twelve (12) months thereafter. In the event that the options are exercised, the contract term shall be extended by twelve (12) months for each option exercised."

Section I - Contract Clauses, page 24 of the solicitation FAR 52.219-6, Notice of Small -Business Set-Aside (JUL 1996) - Alternate 1 (Oct 1995) is deleted in its entirety.

The attached DD 1423, Contract Data Requirement List, hereby replaces what was originally attached to the Statement of Work.


