Labor Category:

Research Engineer

Education/Experience

Individuals shall have at least 6 years experience in providing engineering and technical support to advanced technology research, development, test and evaluation programs for fleet EW systems. Individual must have experience leading and/or managing the research, development, measurement, integration and evaluation of electronic support and/or electronic combat systems. Individual shall be experienced with threat simulation systems employed to support test and evaluation, test data collection and analysis. Individuals shall have a BS in Science, Engineering or Computer Science or 6 years experience in providing engineering and technical support to advanced technology research, development, test and evaluation programs

Labor Category:

Senior Research Engineer

Individual shall have 10 years experience in planning, scheduling, coordinating measurement and evaluation of complex Radio Frequency (RF), Electroptical (EO), Infrared (IR) and IR EW systems and equipment in laboratory and open-air in-flight tests. Experience providing engineering and technical support to advanced technology research, development, test and evaluation programs for fleet EW systems. Individuals must have a MS in Engineering or Computer Science. A Bachelor's degree in Engineering

or Computer Science plus an additional 4 years of experience in planning, scheduling, coordinating measurement and evaluation of complex (RF), (EO), (IR) and IR EW systems and equipment in laboratory and open-air may be substituted for the master's degree

Individual shall have at least 5 years experience in management support including earned value management, technical performance measurements, requirements estimations and analysis, and funds management. Individuals shall have experience in providing training and implementation of program management disciplines, including earned value management, program management and baseline development. Individual shall have experience providing technology-based systems analysis, documentation and transition guidance. Must have experience in 1) development of baseline documents and program management plans; 2) cost analysis; 3) Earned Value Management calculations, trend analysis and identification.
