Description

This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with the format in Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) Subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; proposals are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued. The solicitation, N00173-05-R-KK08, is issued as a Request for Proposal (RFP). The solicitation document and incorporated provisions and clauses are those in effect through FAC 2001-05-05 and DFARS Change Notice 20050726. The associated small business size standard is 500 employees. . NRL has a requirement for 3 commercial grade shelters, which must be sea worthy after assembly. One shelter is to be a below deck electronic trailer, the second shelter is to be a secure trailer, and the third shelter is to be an above deck array trailer. All shelters are to be stackable, skid mounted, forklift maneuverable and crane lift-able. All three shelters are to be delivered to the Multi-Function Electronic Warfare Facility (MFEWF) at Chesapeake Beach, Md. at the same time. Advance notice of shipping is required for NRL to arrange for a crane required

to off-load the trailers. The complete specification and/or other information required for this combined synopsis/solicitation is available at

Delivery shall be no later than 180 days from date of award. The provision at 52.212-1, Instructions to Offerors-Commercial, applies to this acquisition.

The Government intends to award a contract resulting from this solicitation to that responsible offeror proposing the lowest price for the items that have been determined to comply with the requirements of the specifications and solicitation. The proposal must demonstrate an understanding of the requirement and the ability to meet the specifications.

Any resultant contract will be DO Rated under the Defense Priorities and Allocations System (DPAS). The Contract Specialist must receive any questions concerning the RFP no later than 5 business days before the response date of this solicitation. If facsimile is not used, an original and 2 copies of the offeror proposal shall be received on or before the response date noted above, 4:00 P.M., local time at the NRL address above, Attn: Contracting Officer. The package should be marked with the solicitation number, due date and time.
