Description

This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with the format in Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) Subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; proposals are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued. The solicitation, N00173-05-R-MS06, is issued as a Request for Proposal (RFP). The solicitation document and incorporated provisions and clauses are those in effect through FAC 2001-05-05 and DFARS Change Notice 20050621. The associated small business size standard is 334513 and 500 employees. NRL has a requirement for short wave hyperspectral imager. CLIN 0001: The contractor shall deliver one short wave hyperspectral imager, that must contain a hyperspectral imager, a controller, data acquisition and storage, software to operate the system and store and retrieve data, documentation of optical and electrical specifications of the

system, and user manual. in accordance with the specifications. CLIN 0002: Data in accordance with the Contract Data Requirements List, DD 1423.

Delivery and acceptance is at NRL, Washington, D.C. 20375, FOB Destination. Delivery shall be no later than six months from date of award. The provision at 52.212-1, Instructions to Offerors-Commercial, applies to this acquisition.

The Government intends to award a contract resulting from this solicitation to that responsible offeror proposing the lowest price for the items that have been determined to comply with the requirements of the specifications and solicitation. The proposal must demonstrate an understanding of the requirement and the ability to meet the specifications.

The provision at FAR 52.212-2, Evaluation--Commercial Items is incorporated. The Government intends to award a contract resulting from this solicitation to that responsible offeror whose offer conforming to the solicitation will be the most advantageous to the Government, price and other factors considered.

The following factors shall be used to evaluate the offers: (i) technical capability of the item offered to meet the Government requirement; (ii) price; and (iii) past performance. Technical and past performance, when combined are more important than price.

The following additional FAR clause applies: 52.214-31. Facsimile proposals are authorized and may be forwarded to the contract specialist point of contact provided below.

All EIT supplies and services provided under any resultant contract must comply with the applicable accessibility standards issued by the Architectural and Transportation Barriers Compliance Board at 36 CFR part 1194 (see FAR Subpart 39.2). Electronic and information technology (EIT) is defined at FAR 2.101.

Any resultant contract will be DO Rated under the Defense Priorities and Allocations System (DPAS). The Contract Specialist must receive any questions concerning the RFP no later than August 11, 2005. An original and 2 copies of the offeror's proposal shall be received on or before the response date noted above, 3:00 P.M., local time at the NRL address above, Attn: Contracting Officer. The package should be marked with the solicitation number, due date and time.
