

## **PRESCRIPTION SAFETY GLASS SPECIFICATION**

The contractor shall supply the Prescription Safety Glasses in accordance with Attachment 2 and the following related information.

### **BACKGROUND**

The glasses will be fit by the optometrist (under contract) upon their arrival at the Naval Research Laboratory. If the optometrist determines that they were not made per his written prescription, the optical company must cover the cost of remaking the glasses. If he finds that the prescription must be rewritten, the cost will be treated as a new work order. The average orders are placed every two weeks with 18 – 20 pairs of glasses ordered. Individual pairs maybe ordered.

### **TECHNICAL**

Prescriptions are written for all types of single vision, bifocal, trifocals and progressive lens as shown in Attachment 2.

The contractor must provide frames in a choice of TITMIS TR306S, TR301S, and TR304S.

### **APPLICABLE DOCUMENTS AND STANDARDS**

The safety glasses must comply with ANSIZ87.1-2003 and Z87-2 Safety Standards

### **WARRANTIES**

The contractor must provide a standard commercial warranty as provided to the public.
