18 -- SPACE FLIGHT QUALIFIED REACTION WHEELS

Description

This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with the format in Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) Subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; proposals are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued. The solicitation, N00173-06-R-RS05, is issued as a Request for Proposal (RFP). The solicitation document and incorporated provisions and clauses are those in effect through FAC 2005-09 and DFARS Change

Notice 20060519. The associated NAICS code is 741710 and the small business size standard is 1000 employees. The Naval Research Laboratory Center for Space Technology has a requirement for three Space Flight Qualified Reaction Wheels. Offerors may propose a fourth wheel for delivery as an option, but only if required for product requalification. If Offeror determines that a requalification unit is not necessary, Offeror shall provide analysis or test results to demonstrate that proposed units are qualified. Alternately, the Offeror may provide documentation on how the offered product is qualified by similarity for the Government to review. If Offeror determines a requalification unit is necessary, Offeror shall document and provide explanation of the need for requalification based on changes to be made to existing units to conform with the Government's operational and environmental requirements. Offeror proposals shall also identify any costs associated with product requalification. Proposal of an optional fourth wheel for requalification does not obligated the Government to exercise that option. Delivery shall be no later than 365 days from date of award. The Government would prefer delivery within 270 days from the date of award. The Contractor's proposal shall also include the following administrative information, if available: DUNS Number, CAGE Code, and TIN Number. The provision at 52.212-1, Instructions to Offerors--Commercial, applies to this acquisition. The provision at FAR 52.212-2, Evaluation--Commercial Items is incorporated. The Government intends to award a contract resulting from this solicitation to that responsible offeror whose offer, conforming to the solicitation, will be the BEST VALUE to the Government, price and other factors considered. The following factors shall be used to evaluate the offers: (a) technical capability of the items offered to meet the minimum needs of the Government based on examination of either product literature or technical approach narrative, or both; (b) Past Performance (see FAR 52.212-1(b)(10)); and (c) Price. Technical Capability and Past Performance, when combined, are of greater importance than Price. The Government will evaluate offers for award purposes by adding the total price for all options to the total price for the basic requirement. The Government may determine that an offer is unacceptable if the option prices are significantly unbalanced. Evaluation of options shall not obligate the Government to exercise the option(s).
