Description

This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with the format in Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) Subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; proposals are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued. The solicitation, N00173-06-R-TA02, is issued as a Request for Proposal (RFP). The solicitation document and incorporated provisions and clauses are those in effect through FAC 2005-06 and DFARS Change Notice 20051209. The associated small business size standard is 500 employees. NRL has a requirement for the following: Contract Line Item Number (CLIN) 0001, Solid State Nanosecond Laser System, 1 LO; CLIN 0002 Operation and Maintenance Manuals, 1 LO. Delivery and acceptance are at NRL Washington, D.C. 20375, FOB Destination. Delivery shall be no later than ninety (90) days from date of award. The provision at FAR 52.212-2, Evaluation--Commercial Items is incorporated. The Government intends to award a contract

resulting from this solicitation to that responsible offeror whose offer conforming to the solicitation will be the most advantageous to the Government, price and other factors considered. The following factors shall be used to evaluate the offers: The following factors shall be used to evaluate the offers: 1. Technical Capabilities- Compliance with the enclosed technical specifications is of paramount importance. 2. Company Experience - the Contractor should provide convincing evidence of similar products delivered, installed and supported. 3. Past Performance - For evaluation purposes, the contractor should provide past performance information on contracts with Government agencies and private industry, which demonstrates quality of work. Demonstrating this should include lists of contacts with phone numbers of references. 4. Price. Technical Capability, Company Experience and Past Performance when combined shall be considered at least as important as price.
