The purpose of this amendment is to provide answers to questions received from potential offerors.

1. Q: Can you confirm whether this will be on site or off site (contractor facility) support?

A: It is the expectation that the majority of the work under this RFP will be performed at NRL. This should not preclude the possibility that some work may also be performed at the contractor's site.

2. Q: Section L-12 (B), Technical Understanding, requests in three paragraphs, three distinct submission efforts. There seems to be a significant amount of overlap between the first and second paragraph requirements – in other words, many of the SOW task areas involve many of the discreet technical requirements listed in the second paragraph. Do you require separate and distinct responses to each paragraph (which may be repetitive) or should there be one response that highlight each of those areas within the SOW tasks?

A: Due to the technical nature of the work there may be significant overlap in demonstrating understanding of the tasks areas and demonstrating understanding of the list of discreet technical requirements as required by Section L-12 (B). Responders need not respond specifically to requirements of both the statement of work and the list of discreet technical requirements but if they choose to make a single response should include sufficient detail to document their full understanding of the tasks and the specific technical requirements for each task area within the SOW.

3. Q: The introduction to the SOW identifies 9 task areas. The SOW then provides task description for 11 task areas. Tasks 2 through 6 match in both areas. Task I in the introduction describes C4I Analysis & Development, while Task I in the task descriptions describes C4I segment maintenance. Task VII – IR Seeker Simulation Hardware and Algorithms and Task VIII Computer System Administrator do not appear in the introductory lists of tasks, but do appear in the task descriptions. Task VII through IX on the introductory list of tasks then match tasks IX through XI in the task descriptions. Can you please clarify which list is correct, to include which description of Task I should govern?

A: The C4I Analysis and Development research under Task I is long term research project that is in a mature stage. It is expected that most of the analysis and development work has been completed and the majority of continuing work will include maintenance and updating of that work however new technology or techniques may dictate a refocusing of work on analysis and development during this contract. Responders should address understanding and ability to perform maintenance type functions for components of the DII COE (C4I) compliant C4I systems as noted in the last paragraph of the description of Task I.

The abbreviated list of tasks is intended only as a quick reference list and not to describe tasks to be performed under this contract. Responders should address responses to requirements described in the paragraphs detailing tasks descriptions.

4. Q: On DD form 1423, the Contract Data Requirements List, the block 16 remarks for Data Item A003 appears to be incomplete. Can you clarify the exact language for this Data Item?

A: Block 16 remarks for Data Item A003 were inadvertently truncated due to lack of space and should end with the following data; "Recent Funding, Available Balance."
