The purpose of this amendment is to add additional labor categories, revise the personnel qualifications and to provide answers to questions received from potential offerors.

1. Four new labor categories are added to support Tasks 3.1.9 and 3.1.10 and are reflected in the revised Section H-3.
2. Attachment (3) – Personnel Qualifications is revised to reflect the additional labor categories as follows:

Senior Software Engineer: Must have a Bachelor's degree and a minimum of ten (10) years experience in software development, specifically related to aerospace systems. SECRET clearance required.

Software Engineer: Must have a Bachelor's degree and a minimum of five (5) years experience in software development, specifically related to aerospace systems. SECRET clearance required.

Senior Systems Engineer: Must have a Bachelor's degree and a minimum of ten (10) years experience in engineering, systems integration, testing, application analysis and design. SECRET clearance required.

Systems Engineer: Must have a Bachelor's degree and a minimum of five (5) years experience in engineering, systems integration, testing, application analysis and design. SECRET clearance required.

3. Q: Section H-3, page 9: Should the total hours of direct labor be \$13,440? Section H-3, page 10: Should the number of labor hours for each labor category be 1,920?
3. A: Section **H-3, LEVEL OF EFFORT** is revised to add additional labor categories and to correct the number of labor hours specified in paragraph a, b, and k as follows:
  - (a) The Contractor agrees to provide the total level of effort specified in the next sentence in performance of the work described in this contract. The total level of effort for performance of this contract shall be 23,040 total hours of direct labor for the Basic award, 23,040 for each of the four Option Years, if exercised, including subcontractor direct labor for those subcontractors specifically identified in the Contractor's proposal as having hours included in the proposed level of effort. A breakdown of labor categories and hours is set forth in paragraph (k) below.

(b) The level of effort for this contract shall be expended at an average rate of 1,920 hours per month. It is understood and agreed that the rate of hours per month may fluctuate in pursuit of the technical objective, provided such fluctuation does not result in the use of the total hours of effort prior to the expiration of the term of the contract.

(k) The anticipated breakdown by labor category of the total level of effort is as follows:
