The purpose of this amendment is to answer questions from prospective offerors.

Question 1: I didn't see a cut-off date for questions so I am forwarding a few more?

Answer 1: The cut-off date to send questions is 24 January 2008 unless bringing to view a mistake in the specifications.

Question 2: General Requirements- "The contractor shall provide for the creation of illustrations, drawings, and other graphic material required by various programs, studies, proposals, or technical presentations." Is it correct to interpret that this requirement is directly related to the deliverables defined by CDRL-A005 and not as a requirement to provide general graphics support to the NRL RSD?

Answer 2: The prospective contractor's interpretation is correct. This requirement is related to CDRL A005. The graphics support is to be only for tasks on which the contractor is performing technical work, not for other activities within the Division.

Question 3: Government Furnished Information for Task-2. Will the contractor be responsible for total system (PCU and HREP) performance?

Answer 3: Yes, the contractor will be responsible for total system performance.

Question 4: Will the government be responsible for providing ISS, JEM-EF and HTV ICD's, and environmental testing standards and requirements documentation?

Answer 4: Yes, the government will provide the ICD's, testing standards, and requirements. The ICD's have already been negotiated, and will be signed soon.

Question 5: Will the Contractor be responsible for deriving/specifying PCU design factors, such as, but not limited to; form, fit, power, weight, design life, and availability?

Answer 5: No, the Contractor will not be responsible for deriving/specifying the PCU's design factors.

Question 6: Will the government be responsible for providing the requirements for space qualification of the PCU hardware?

Answer 6: Yes, the government will provide the requirements for space qualification. This is really just a variant of question 4.
