The purpose of this amendment is to answer questions posed by a potential offerer. Therefore, the following answers are provided:

1. Regarding Clause L-13, Task 5, Subtask 1, shouldn't the labor category be titled "Electrical Engineer – Analog Circuit Design and Test" ?

Yes.

2. Regarding Clause G-9, paragraph (e)(10) "DD Form 254" , is it the Government's intention to issue a DD254 under each task order versus the basic contract?

The intention is to have a DD 254 for the basic contract, which would generally suffice. However, if a particular task order is of a classified nature, the Government reserves the right to include a DD 254 in that specific task order.

3. Regarding Attachment No. 3, Page 3, Research Scientist –Wafer Bonding, did the Government really intend to make this a key position?

No.

4. Regarding Attachment No. 3, Page 2, Electrical Engineer – Electrical Circuit Design, did the Government really intend to make this a key position?

Yes. Although the short term need is for a part time engineer to design and test miniature radar jammers for electronic warfare applications (Task 1, Subtask 7) , in the longer term, design, fabrication and test of miniature microwave circuits for a variety of DOD applications is anticipated. From time to time, evaluation is also needed of microwave devices developed at NRL and other laboratories. (Task 1, Subtask 5).

5. Regarding Clause L-14 "Anticipated Travel Requirements", is there a preferred city on the East Coast to use for costing purposes? Also, does the Government anticipate any travel to the West Coast?

The following additional information is provided on anticipated travel requirements:

Task 1 - Under subtask 7, travel to NWSC, Dahlgren, VA is anticipated.

Boston, MA is considered to be a likely destination for planning purposes. No West Coast travel is anticipated.

Task 2 - No West Coast Travel is anticipated.

Task 3 – There is no preferred East Coast city to use for costing purposes. One West Coast trip per year for one person for three days should be added for each year.

Task 4 - All of the information at Section L-14 should be deleted for this task and replaced with the following information:

Contractors performing on this task are expected to travel around the US, Canada and Europe for experiments. Locations uses are 1) the tandem accelerator test facility at Brookhaven National Laboratory at Yaphank, NY, 2) the proton test facility at Crocker Nuclear Laboratory at UC Davis in Davis, California, 3) the high energy heavy ion cyclotron facility at Michigan State University in East Lansing, Michigan, 4) the TRIUMF (tri-university meson facility) in Vancouver, British Columbia, 5) the LBL cyclotron at UC Berkeley in Berkeley, California, 6) the heavy ion microbeam at GSI in Darmstadt, Germany, 7) the very high energy heavy ion facility at GANIL in Caen, Normandy, France; and 8) the Indiana University Cyclotron in Bloomington, Indiana The following estimate of travel should be used for each of the five years:
